## Resources Replacing the CA ECE Competencies Mapping Tool

The purpose of this memo is to inform the public of the changes relating to the CA ECE Competencies Mapping Tool (Mapping Tool) and provide information for the existing resources for faculty and practitioners to utilize in place of the Mapping Tool. Faculty have the opportunity to have their courses reviewed by the Curriculum Alignment Project (CAP) to establish course alignment. The alignment process is up to date with the current state standards, the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing Child Development Permit application requirements including the recent development and additions of the Teacher Performance Expectations (TPEs) and Methods of Evaluation (MOEs), California Community College Chancellors Office Course Identification Numbering System (C-ID), and works in collaboration with the California Community College efforts supporting Open Educational Resources (OER) and Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) alignment with ECE/CD courses.
